COMMUNITY MEMBERS

Library Access Membership allows access to UTS Library, computer use, select databases, and printing. Community Borrower Membership additionally allows you to borrow items.

Login Details

An email containing two logins will be sent to you once you register for access to UTS Library. The first allows you access to the Community Member computers on Level 2, and the second allows access to Community Databases. If you have a Community Borrower Membership, this also allows you access to your MyLibrary account.

Computer Use

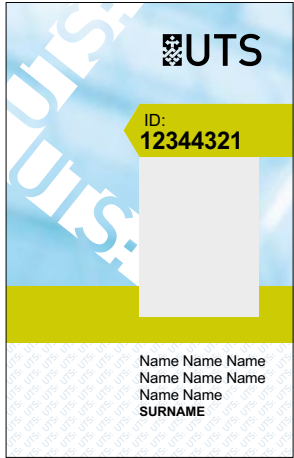
Community Members have a designated row of computers available on Level 2. Please ask at the Research Help Desk for assistance.

Printing & Copying

Facilities > Printing

Use your Community Membership Card to load credit onto your account. This can be done using EFTPOS or cash (\$1 minimum).

The Print & Copy Room is located on Level 2 of the Library.



DAY VISITORS

Your Day Visitor card allows you access to the Library for one day. Please return the card to the desk at the end of your visit.

Note: Day Visitors are unable to log in to the computers, print or borrow items.

Copying

Facilities > Printing

Day Visitors can load copying credit onto the Day Visitor card. Any unused credit is non-refundable, so only load as much money as you intend to use.

Tap the Day Visitor card on the card reader located on each copy machine.
