- Redistribute

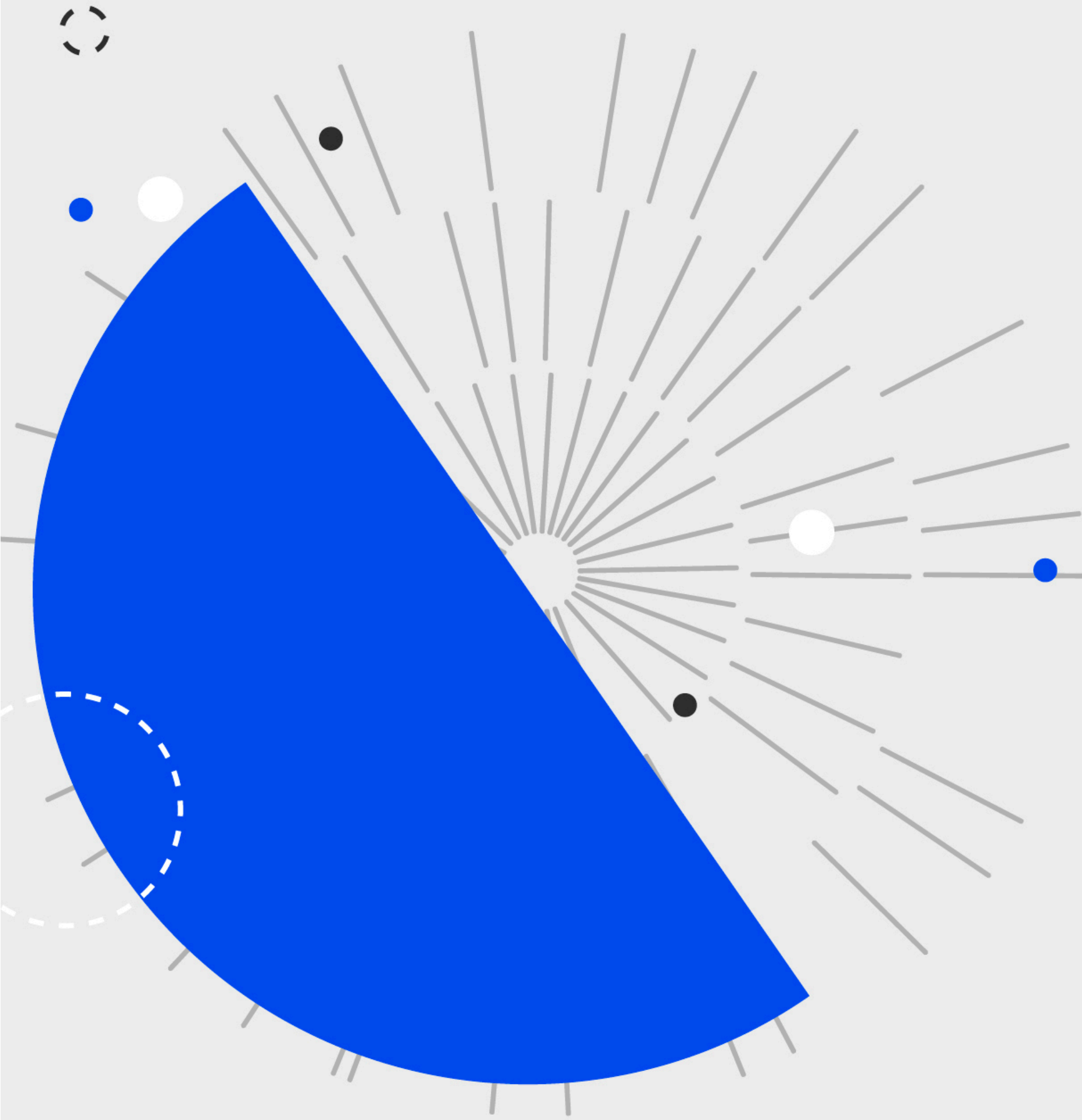




What are Open Educational Resources (OERs)?

- Retain

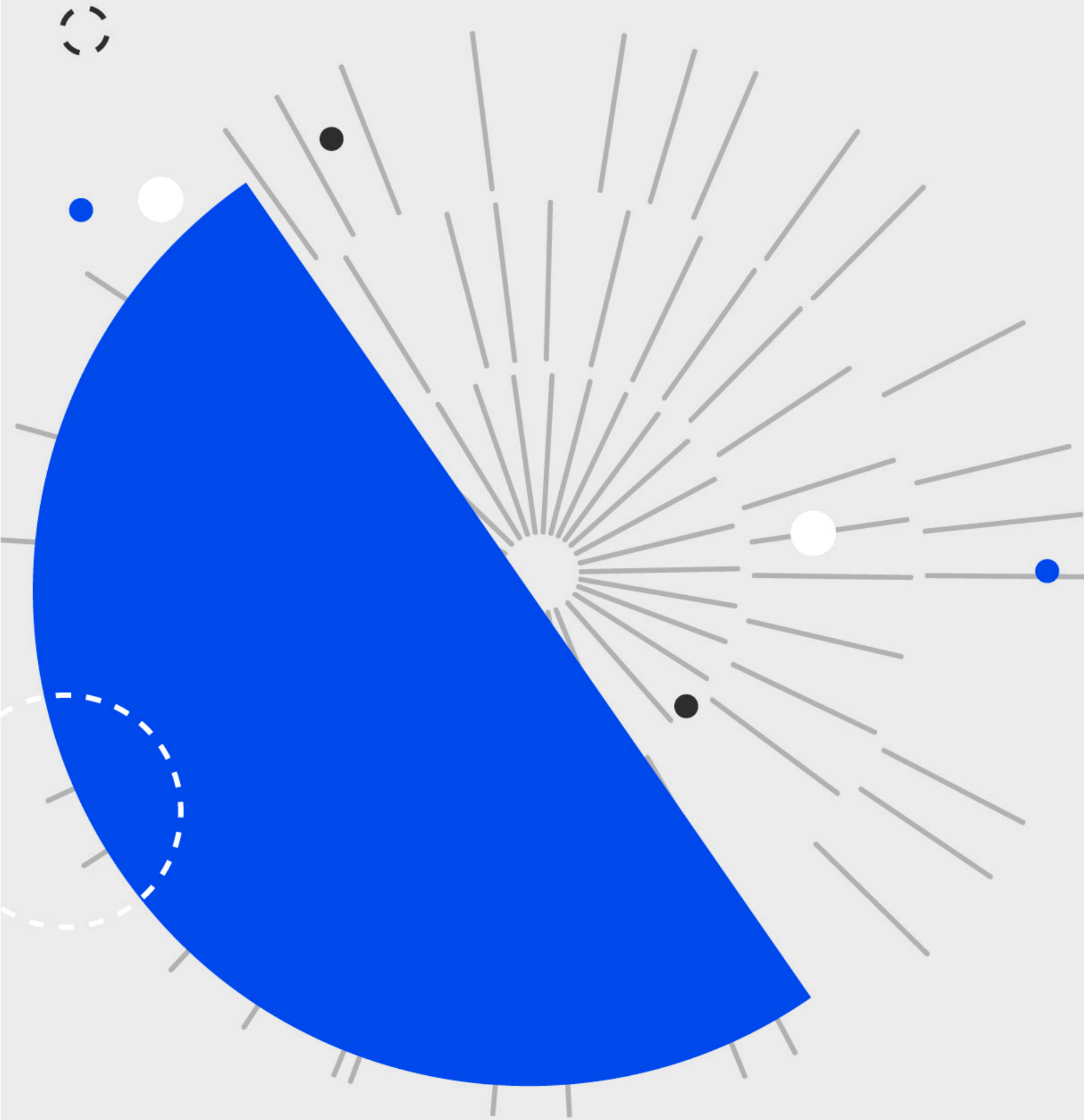
You can keep an archive of the resource for your later use.



What are Open Educational Resources (OERs)?

- **Revise**

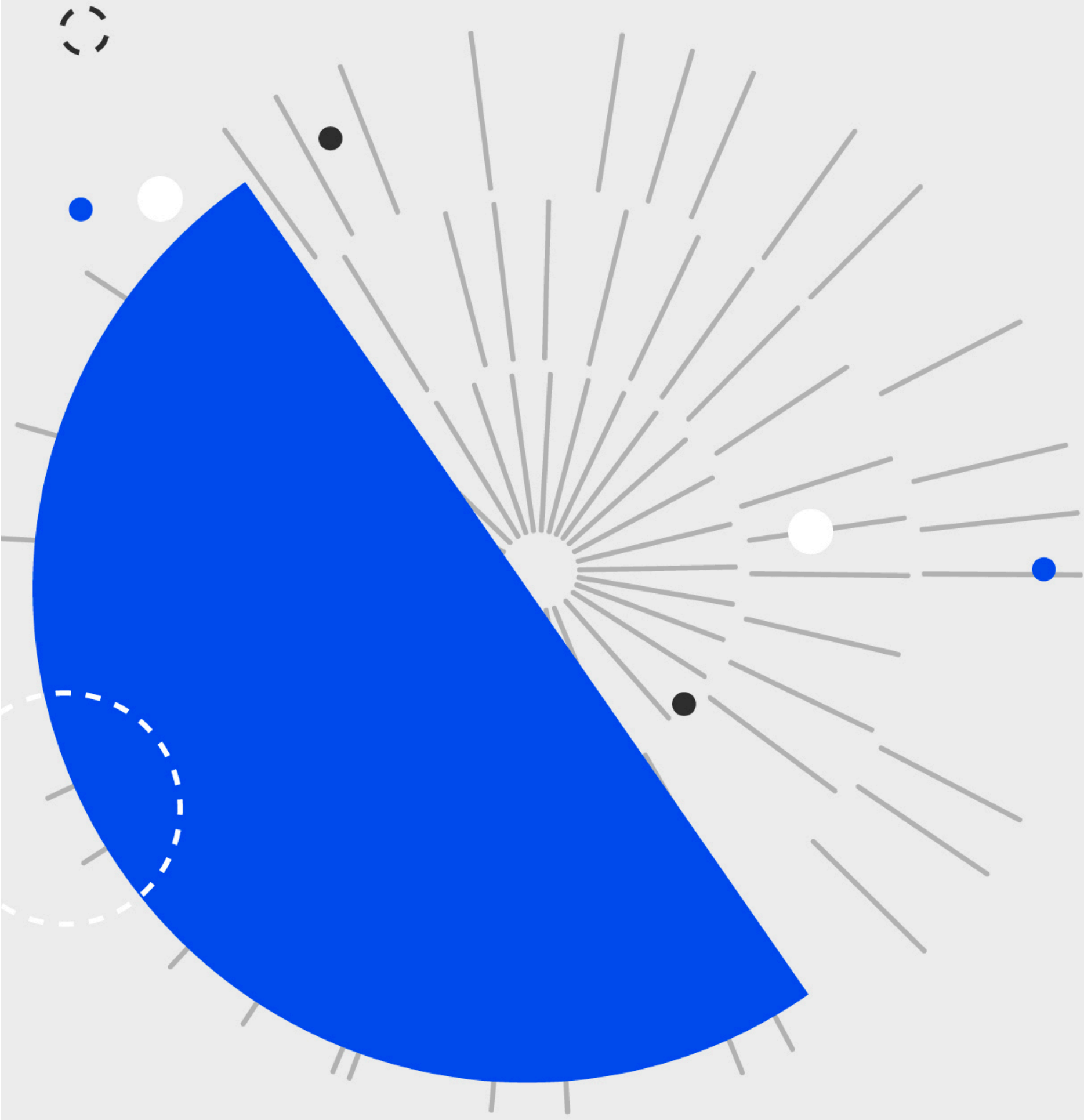
You are free to adapt, update, or otherwise change the resource to meet your own needs.



What are Open Educational Resources (OERs)?

- Reuse

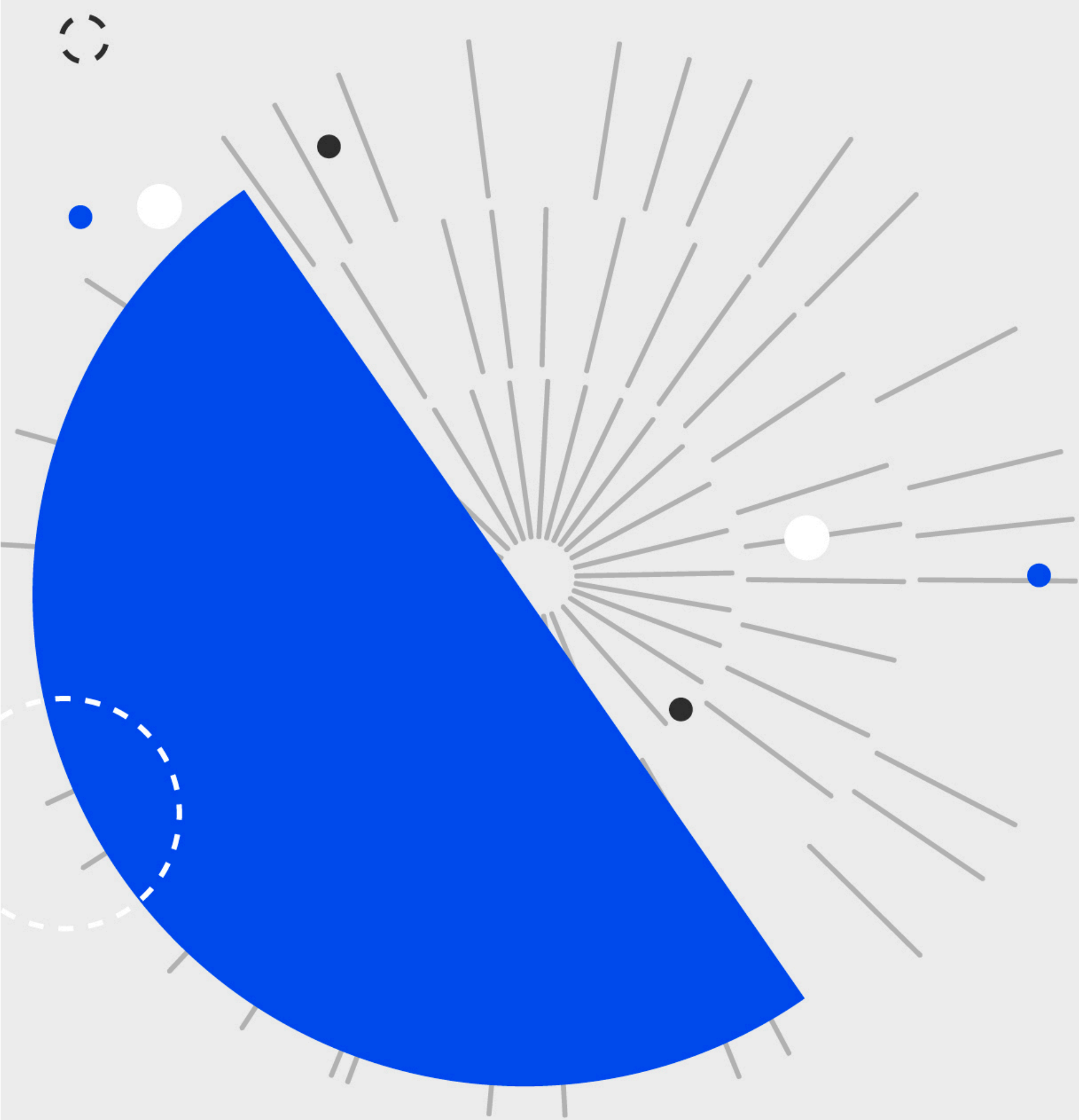
Exactly what it says on the box. You can use the resource as many times as you want or need to.



What are Open Educational Resources (OERs)?

- Remix

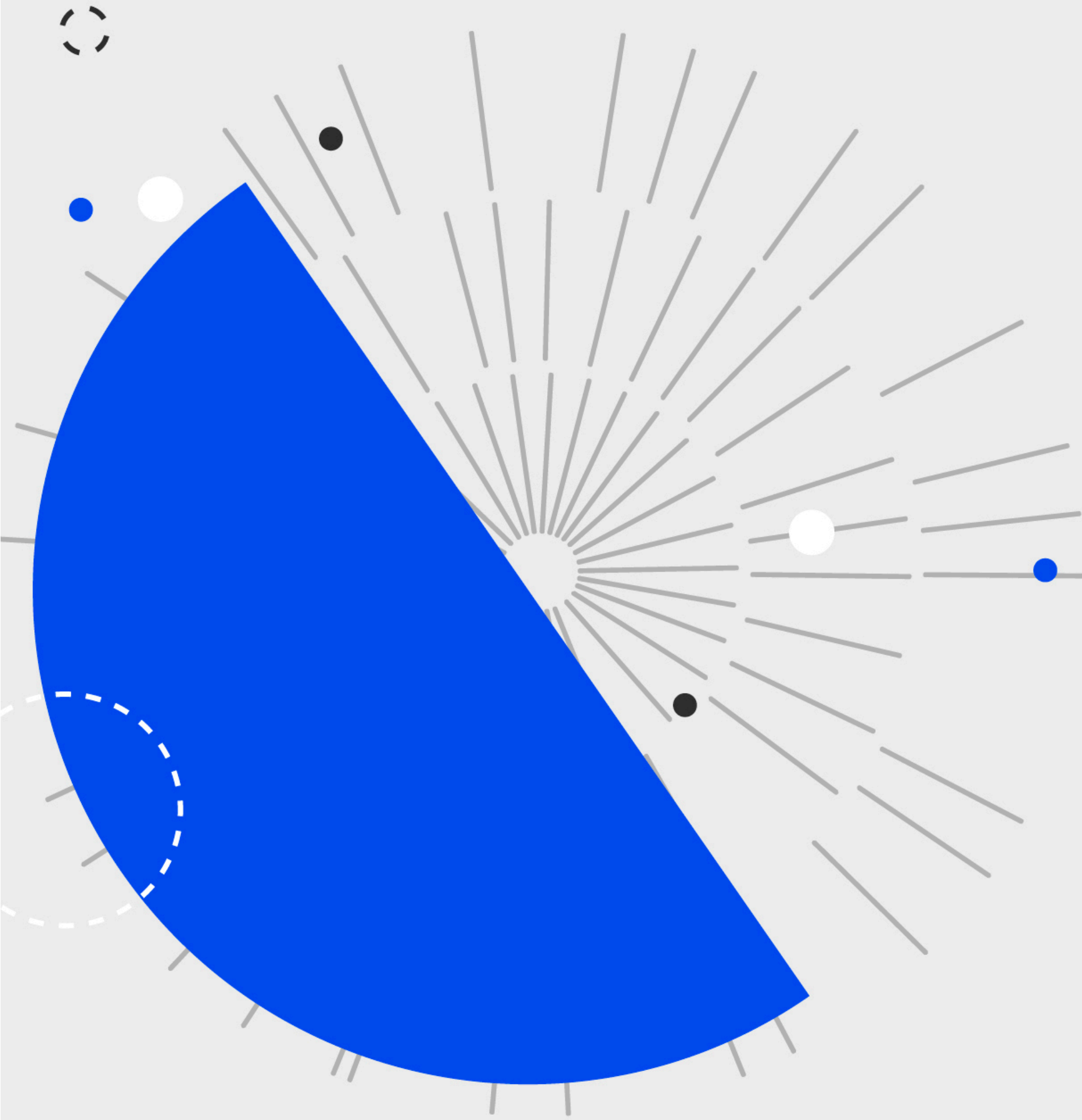
You may combine the resource with other resources (provided you have the legal rights to the other resources)



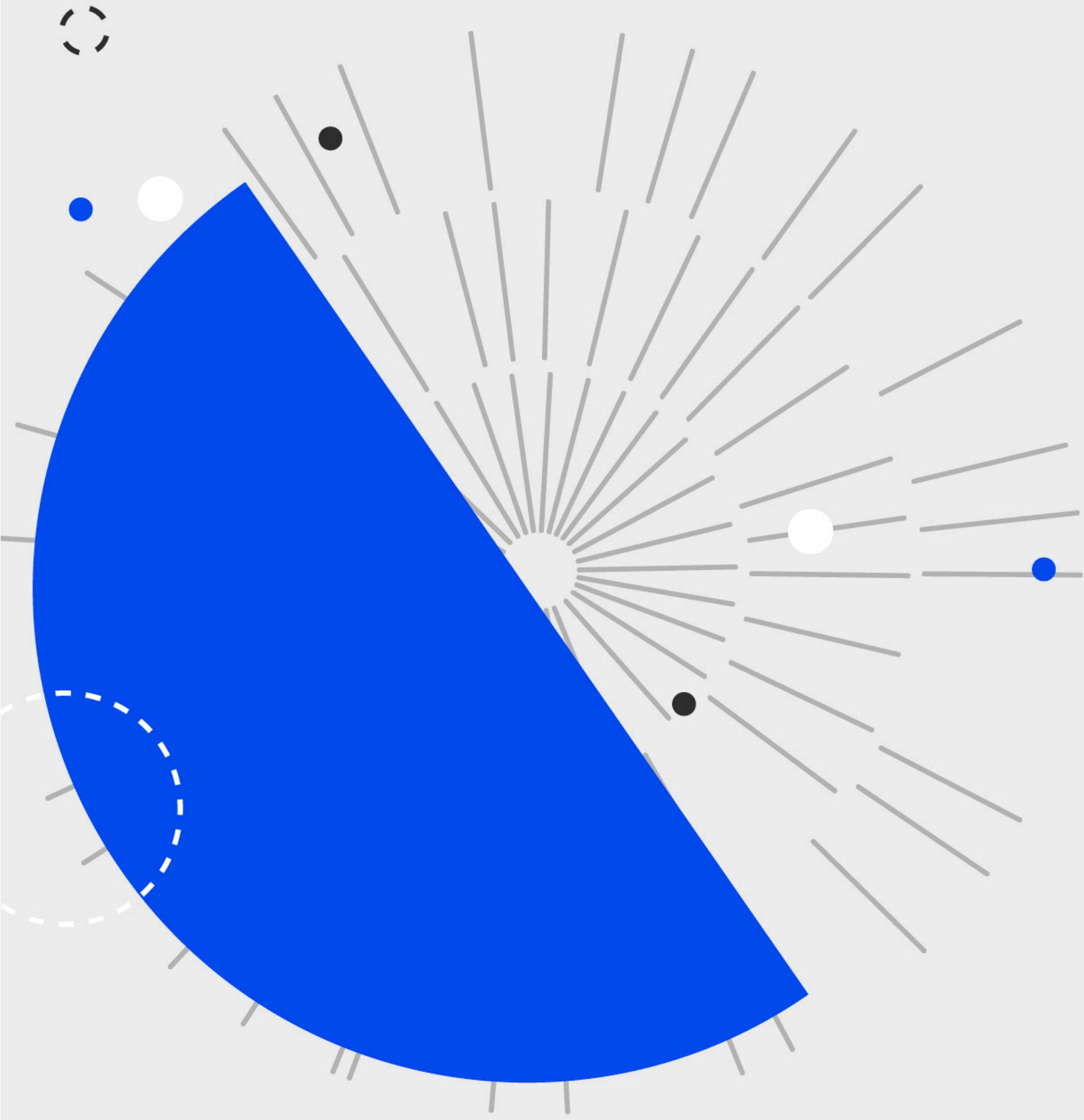
What are Open Educational Resources (OERs)?

- Redistribute

You may share either the original resource or your derivations openly around the world.



Most resources, even those found on 'OER' sites, are not truly OERs.



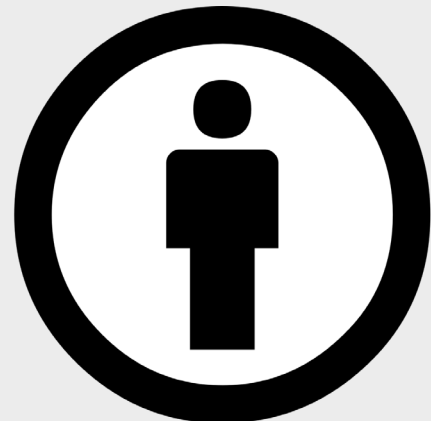
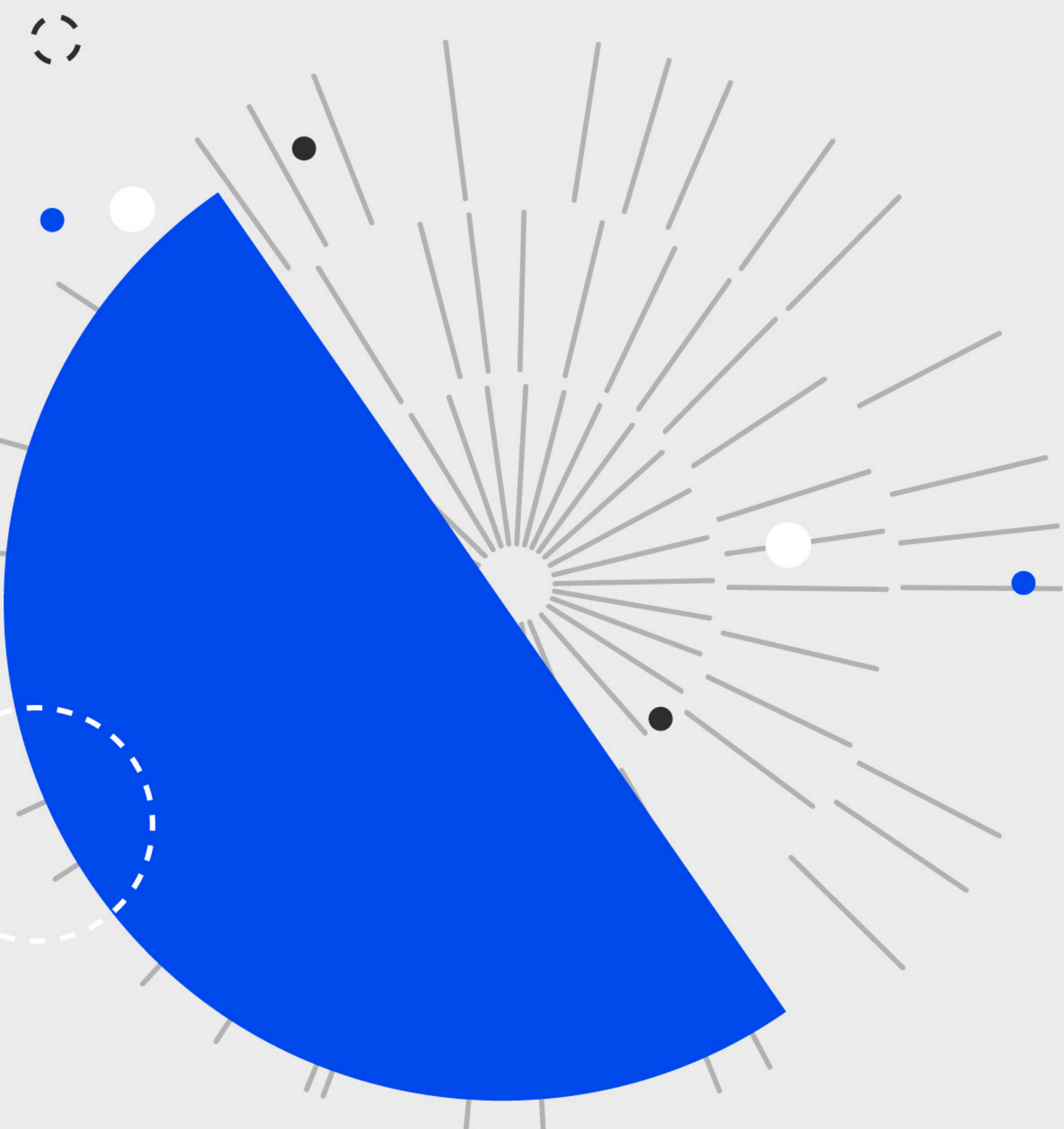
The onus is on you to pay attention to the license, and determine if it meets your needs.

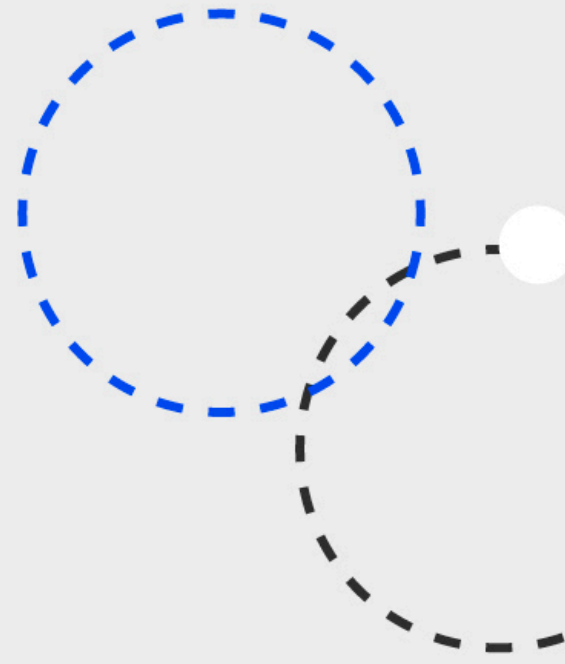


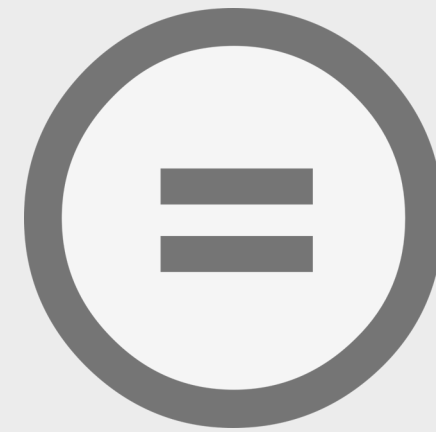
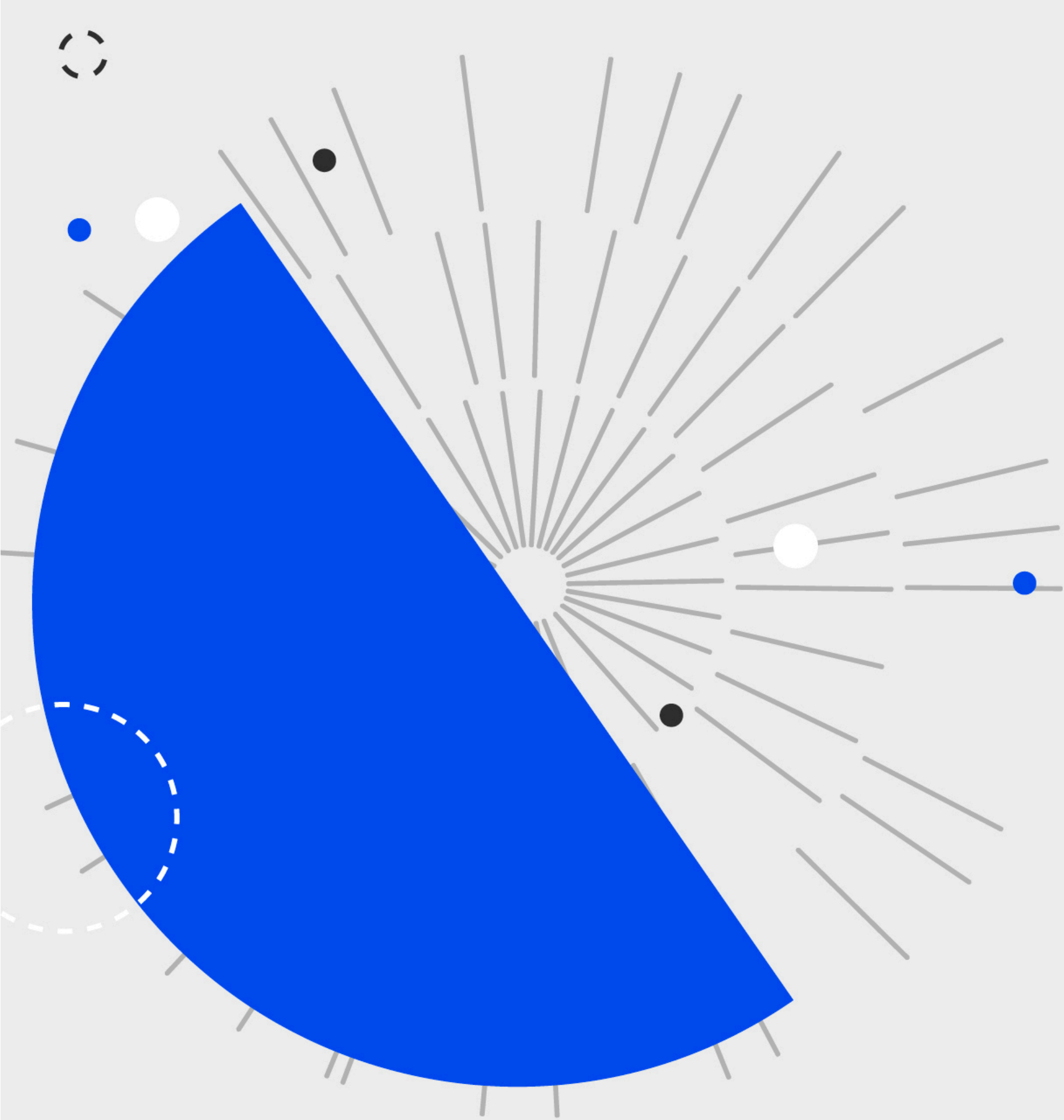


Attribution (BY)



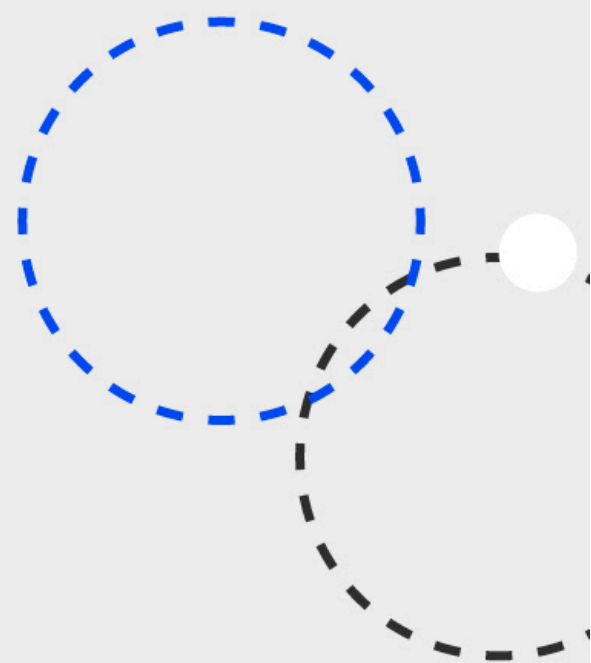
Requires you to properly attribute the creators/owners of the material. Universal.

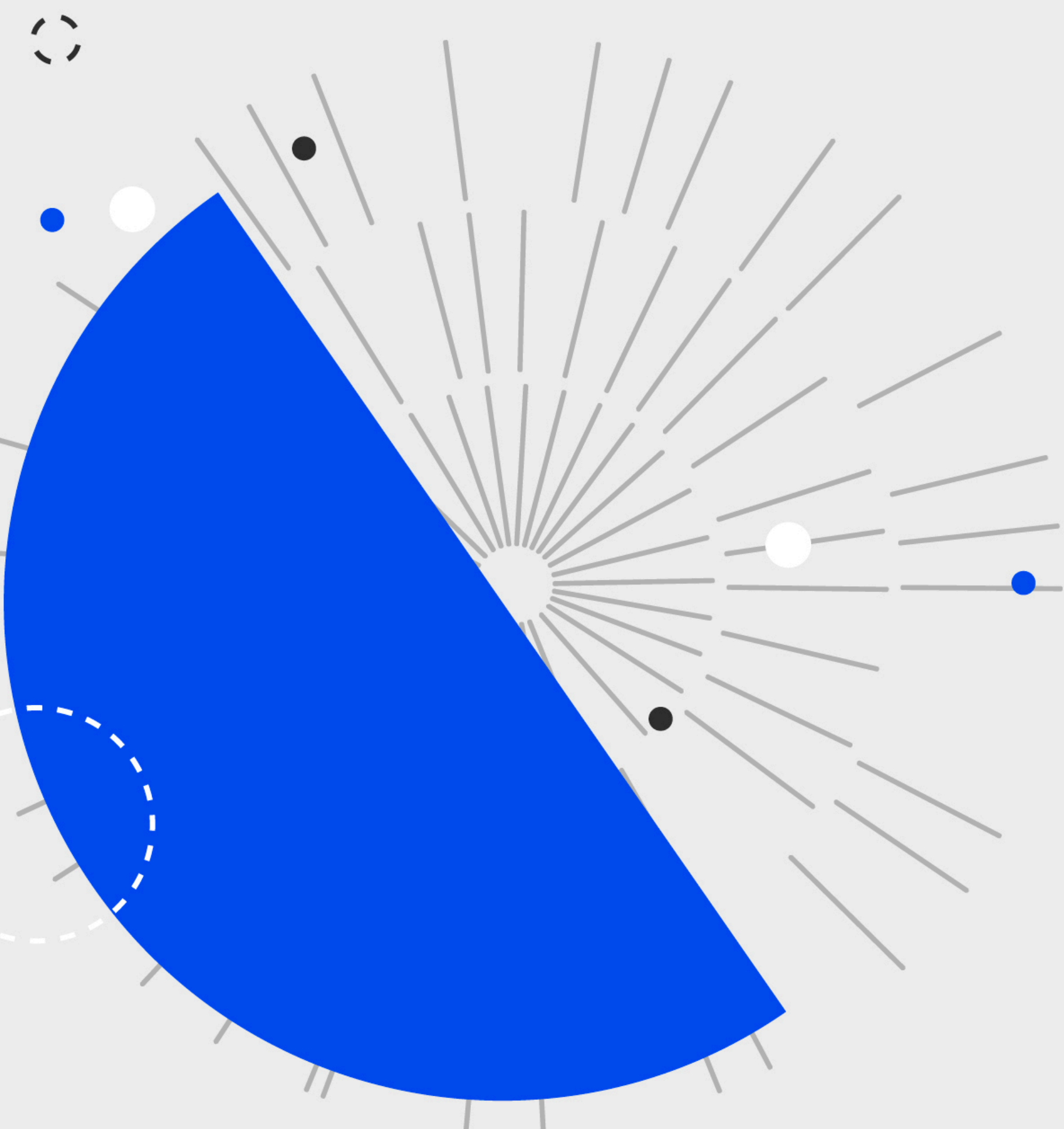




Share-Alike (SA)

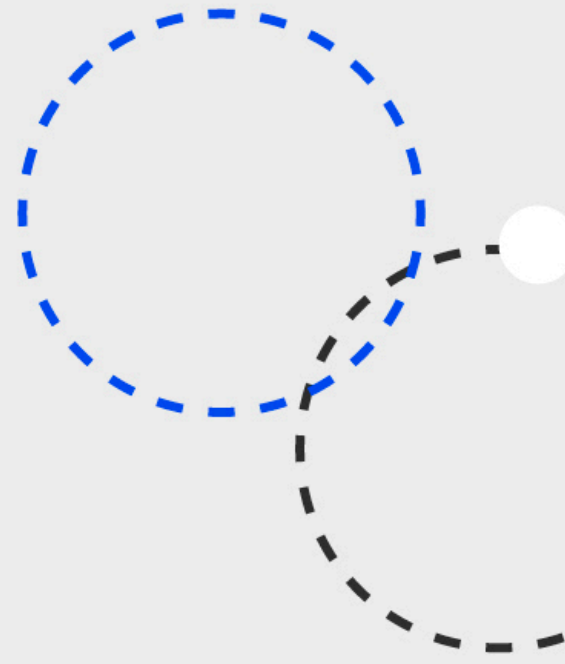
Requires licensor to license any derivative works under same license.

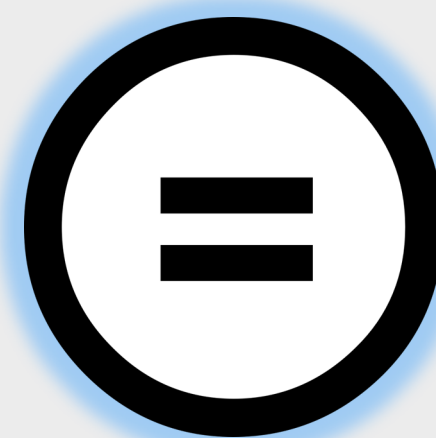
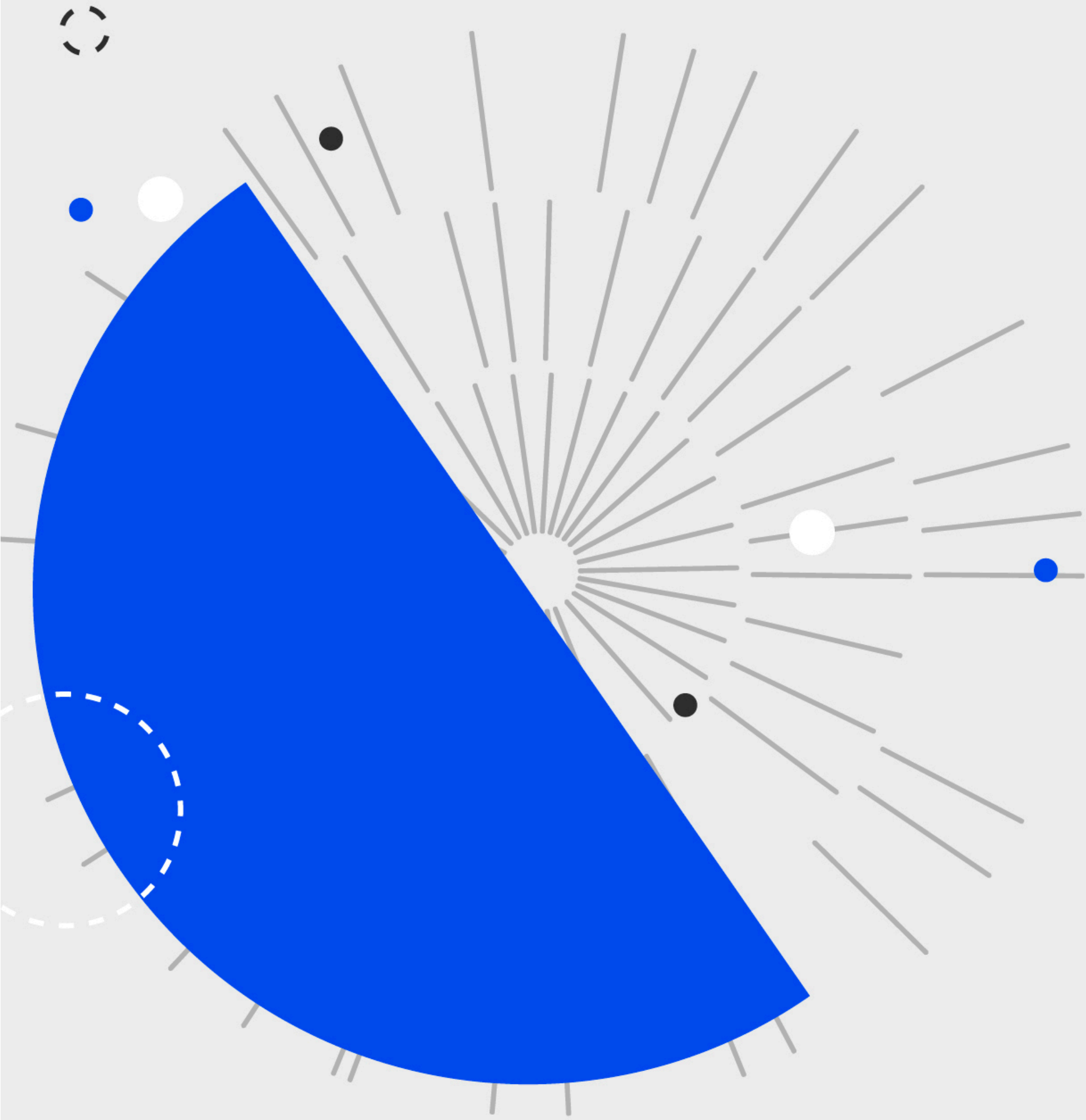




Non-Commercial (NC)

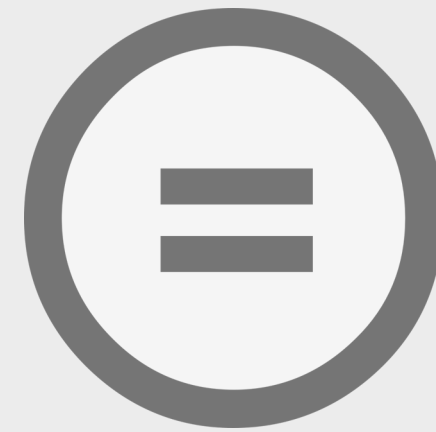
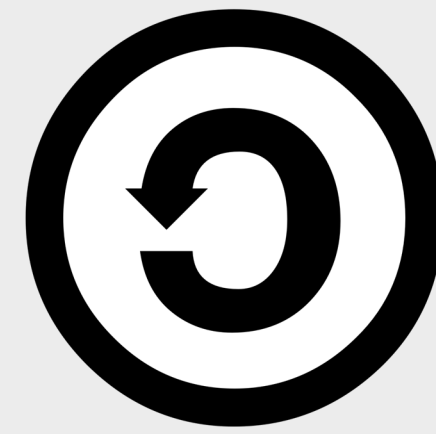
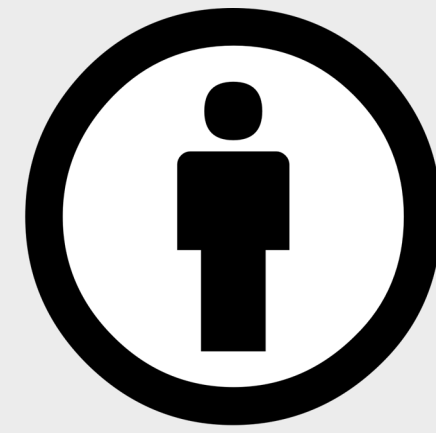
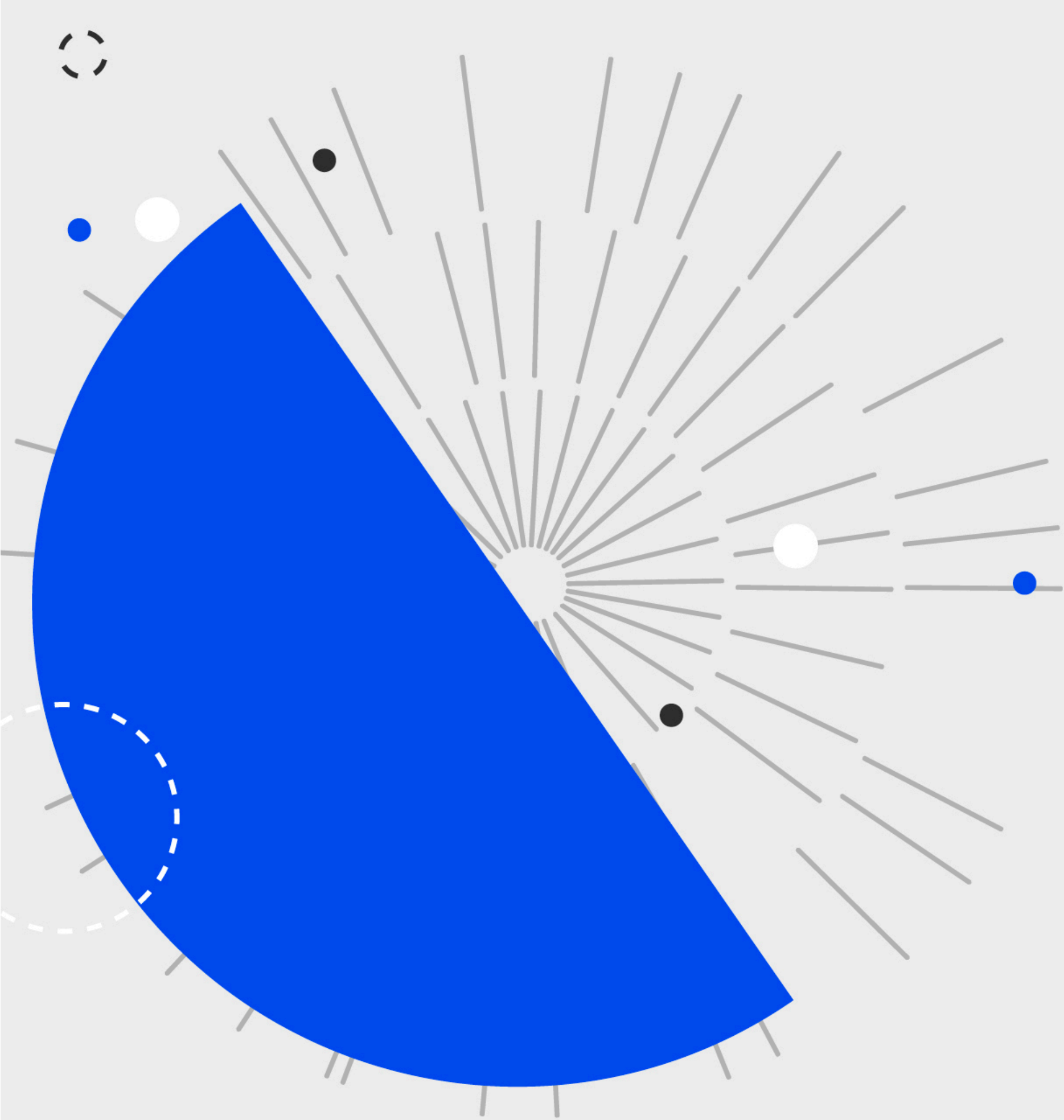
Prohibits use of licensed material within commercial applications.





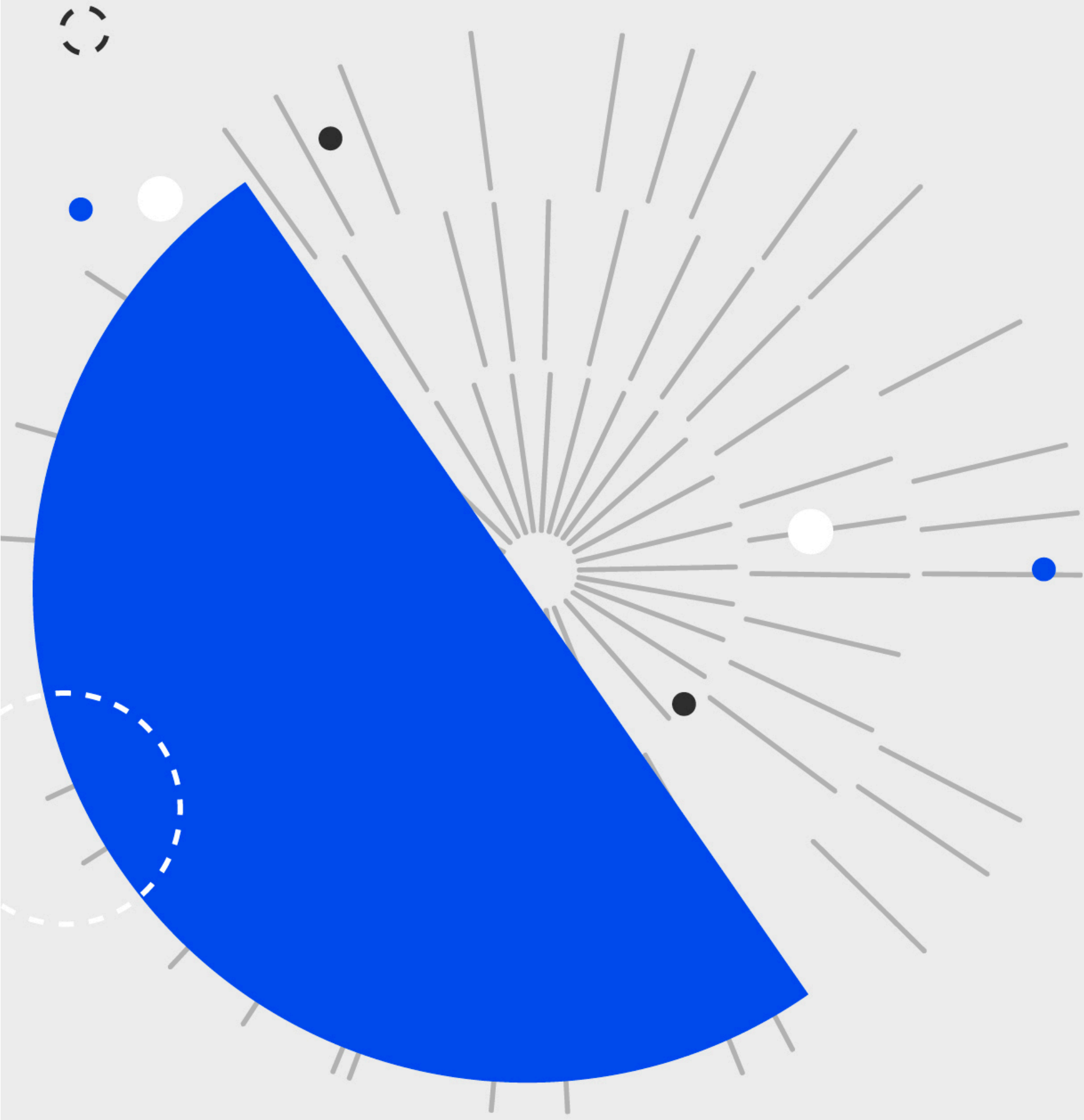
No Derivatives (ND)

Permits only reproduction, not derivation of work. Sometimes called “free publicity” clause.

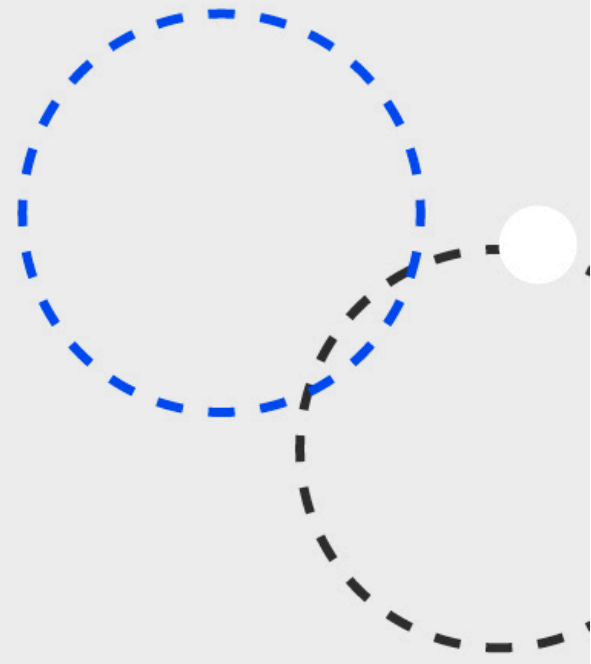
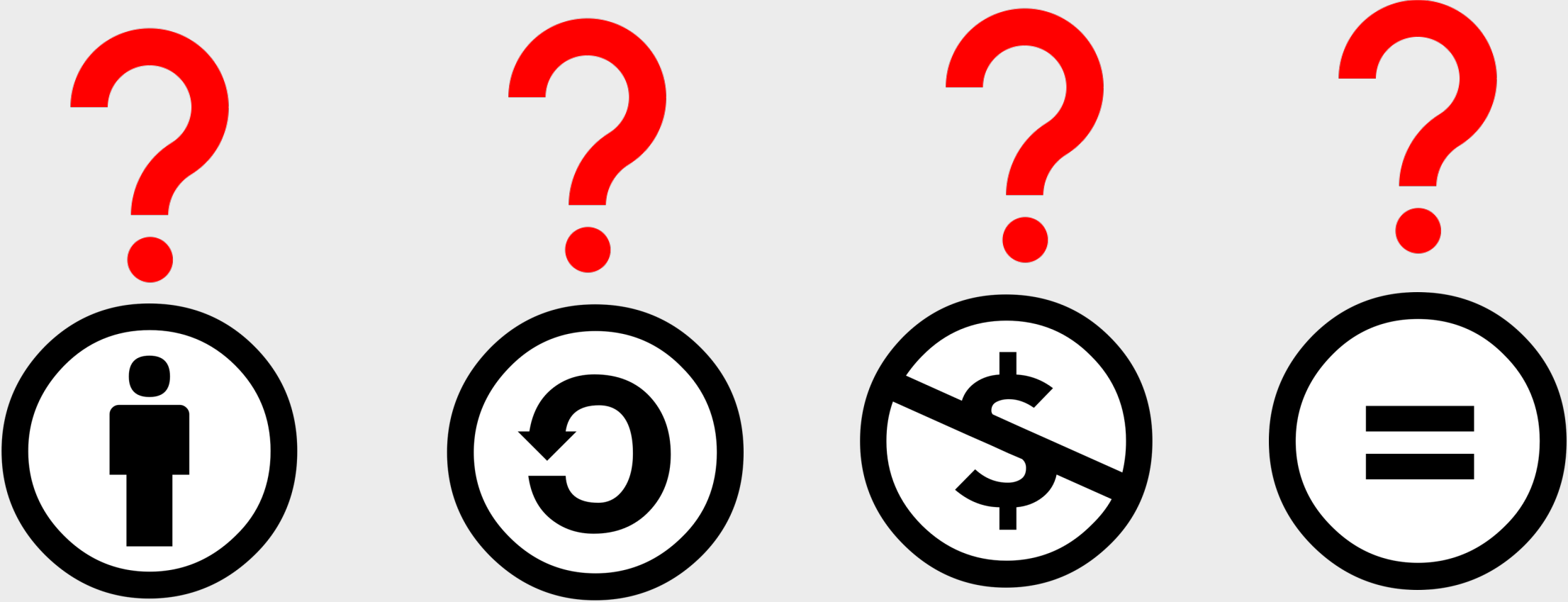


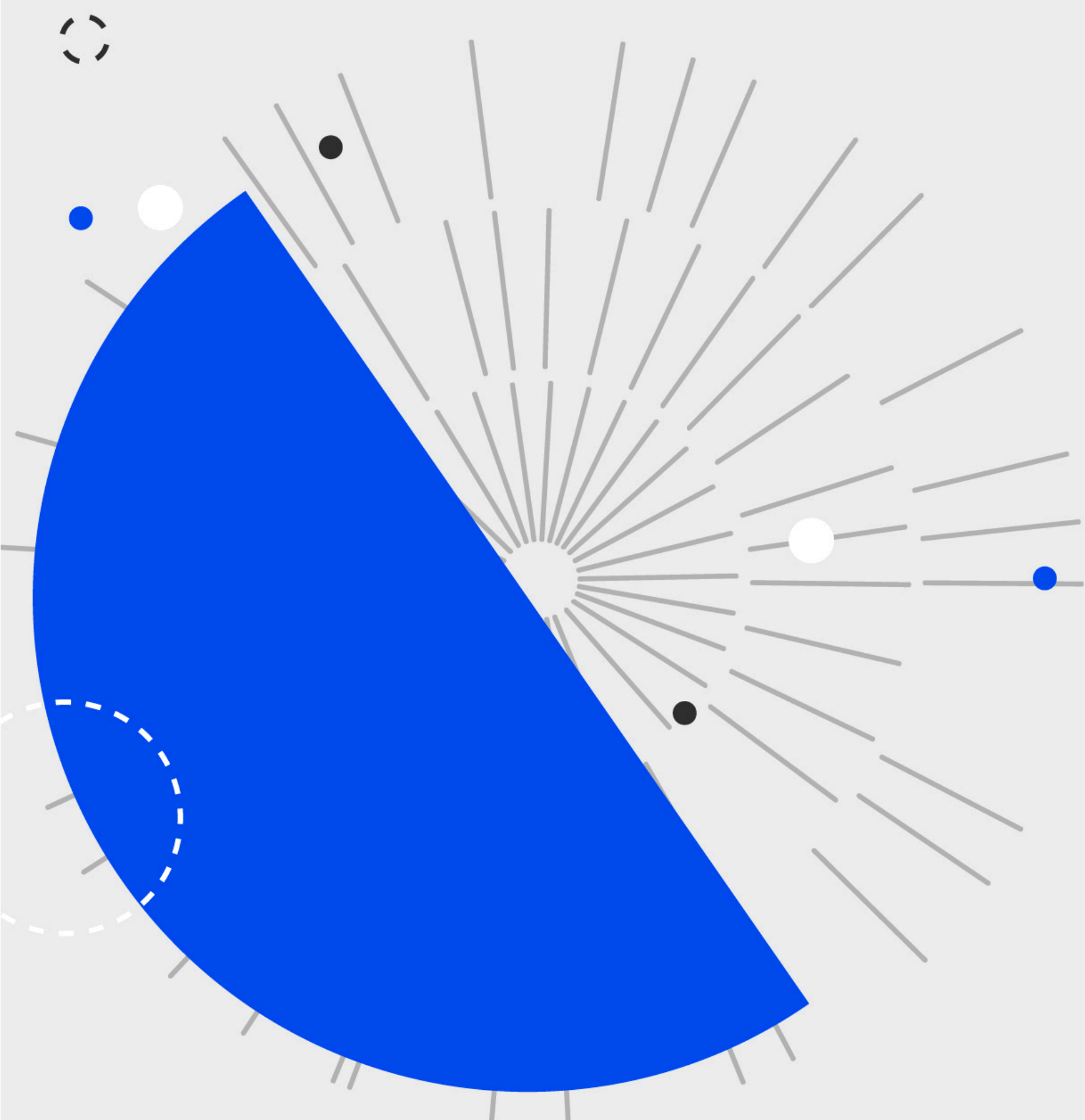
CC BY-SA-NC

Must be properly attributed, made available under same license, not for commercial purpose.



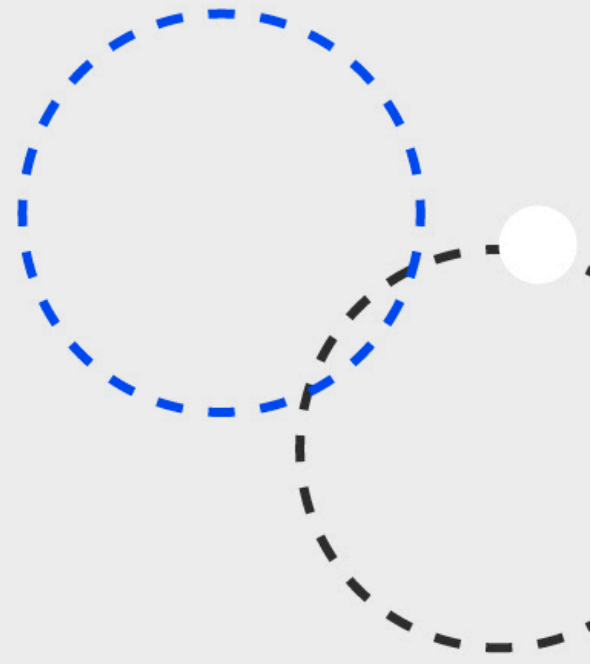
